For self-represented parties only. Not for ballots.

BEFORE YOU FILE

You must follow the procedure in Supreme Court Temporary Rule for Filing in a District Court by a Self-Represented Litigant. Find it using the link above.

All documents must be in a secure, closed envelope.

If fees are due, a check or money order must be with your document in the secure, closed envelope.

You may submit your document without payment if:

- you include a completed poverty affidavit with your filing, or
- a poverty affidavit is on file in your case.

Last pick-up from this drop box is 4 p.m. weekdays.

No pick up will be made on weekends, Supreme Court holidays, or when the court clerk office is closed by court order.
