Shall Unified School District Number 114, Doniphan County, Kansas make an annual tax levy for a period not to exceed four (4) years in an amount not to exceed 3,600 mills upon the assessed taxable tangible property in such school district for the purpose of acquisition, construction, reconstruction, repair, remodeling, additions to, furnishing, maintaining and equipping of school district property and equipment necessary for school district purposes, including computer software; performance uniforms; housing and boarding pupils enrolled in an area vocational school operated under the board; architectural expenses; building sites; undertaking and maintenance of asbestos control projects; school buses; utility expenses; property and casualty insurance; and other fixed assets, and with respect to any redevelopment district established prior to July 1, 2017, pursuant to KSA 12-1771, and amendments thereto, for the purpose of paying a portion of the principal and interest on bonds issued by cities under the authority of KSA 12-1774, and amendments thereto, for the financing of redevelopment projects upon property located within the school district?
